Guidance for students and teachers in isolation due to Covid-like symptoms

This guidance aims to provide clarity on expectations when students and teachers are:

1. isolating due to Covid-like symptoms, and
2. well enough to work or learn

If a student or teacher is unwell, they should not be expected to undertake any work until they have recovered sufficiently.

Student absence	<p>If a student is isolating, they are expected to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. keep up to date with school work as best they can from home.2. check Classcharts and Google Classroom for work set3. email their teachers if work is missing from Classcharts <p>Students are encouraged to stay in contact with their peers.</p> <p>Their teachers will be expected to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● set work as normal on Classcharts and/or Google Classroom● respond to student emails in a timely manner <p>Teachers will not be expected to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● replicate the in-class learning experience for the absent student● create or set additional 'distance learning' provision

Teacher absence	<p>If a teacher is isolating, their classes will be covered.</p> <p>Teachers will be expected to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Set high-quality distance learning work for students● Make all bookings (e.g. chromebooks) in advance● Check the cover list and send the cover work to the relevant teacher, cc'ing in HoD/HoF and cover@stsampsonshigh.sch.gg● Minimise resource preparation and resources required from colleagues in school <p>Students will be expected to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● attend lessons as normal
