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St Sampson's High School Uniform Policy

High standards of dress and personal appearance for all students are an important part of St Sampson's High School. We expect students to take a pride in their appearance and in being a member of the school community. All items, unless indicated, are available from a number of uniform suppliers including **Fletcher Sports, Game Changers** and **Shoestring**.

Uniform Allowance – The States of Guernsey operates a means-tested grant scheme to help parents with the cost of buying school uniforms. Grants are awarded on a sliding scale dependent on the parents' residual income once certain allowances have been made. For further information visit: <https://www.gov.gg/uniform>

All items of clothing should be clearly marked with the student's name.

Years 7 to 11

Blazer	Black blazer with logo on left chest pocket. To be worn at all times.
Jumper	V necked Grey pullover with school logo. (Optional).
Tie	KS3 (Yr 7-9) - Purple tie should be worn at all times KS4 (Yr 10-11) – Purple Striped tie should be worn at all times <i>Different coloured ties will be provided for Prefects.</i>
Skirts /Trousers	Standard full length black trousers, black skirt of appropriate length. (Leggings, jeggings, jeans or similar items are not acceptable). Black tailored shorts. These must be suitable school wear only and purchased from uniform retailers. If a belt is required then it must be plain black.
Shirts	A white long sleeved or short sleeved shirt.
Shoes	Plain black shoes, leather or leather look. (This does not include black trainers, boots, backless, stiletto, canvas, ballet pumps, sling-back or toeless shoes).
Socks and tights	Socks must be plain white if worn with a skirt (no sports logos), or plain black with trousers. Trainer socks are not permitted. Tights must be black
Coats	A sensible school coat which can be worn over the school blazer to and from school and outside during breaktimes. These should not be worn within the building.
Jewellery	Students may wear one pair of plain stud earrings & a wrist watch. No other jewellery may be worn. No other jewellery, including rings and bracelets, facial piercings, bars or belly button piercings – covering with a plaster is unacceptable
Make-Up, Nails & Hair	Discrete makeup may be worn.

Nail varnish/nail extensions/Gels should not be worn. False eyelashes or coloured (cosmetic) contact lenses are not permitted.

Hair colour and hairstyles should not be extreme. Hair should be worn off the face and in a smart sensible style. If you have doubt about a hairstyle/colour please check with the school before any change takes place.

No extreme styles. Tramlines and other razored patterns are not allowed. Grade 2 minimum.

Physical Education

T Shirt	Black Polo with purple trim
Hooded Top	Hooded top/sports jumper with purple trim and school logo (optional)
Shorts/Skort	Black shorts with purple trim/skort Black leggings (optional) Black tracksuit bottoms (optional)
Rugby Shirt	Black and White Rugby Shirt (optional)
Socks	Long black socks (winter) and white sports socks (summer)
Shoes	Sports trainers/football boots (suitable for astro turf/field)
Swimming	Black swim shorts, trunks or one piece swimming costume. Towel. Goggles & Swim cap (optional)
Hockey, Football & Rugby	Football Boots Shin pads (highly recommended) Gum shield (highly recommended)

Students must have a note of explanation from home if for any reason they are not wearing the required dress.

Motorcyclists and pedal cyclists should wear suitable protective clothing.

Books and equipment should be carried in a substantial bag, which should fit inside the locker.
